- HB 861 ARNOLD PETROLEUM/OIL-GAS** Authorizes the use of alternative refrigerants in mobile air conditioning systems

- HB 913 CHAMPAGNE ENVIRONMENT/WATER** Provides for Dept. of Environmental Quality revolving loan programs
- HB 1020 BADON, AUSTIN COASTAL RES/COASTAL ZONE** Provide for buffer zone for borrow pits sites
- HB 1163 ST. GERMAIN ENVIRONMENT/PERMITS** Provides for notice to and review by certain permit holders of changes made by the Dept. of Environmental Quality
- HB 1169 WHITE ENVIRONMENT/AIR** Provides for toxic air pollution emissions
- HB 1177 ST. GERMAIN ENVIRONMENT/WASTE SITES** Provides for the waste tire program
- HB 1253 ST. GERMAIN ENVIRONMENT/SOLID WASTE** Provides for solid waste disposal facility requirements
- HB 1255 BADON, AUSTIN ANIMALS** Provides relative to voluntary surrender of illegal animals to the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries
