6 championship title earned by the St. Amant High School Lady Gators softball team; and

7 WHEREAS, on Saturday, April 30, 2005, the Lady Gators defeated Denham Springs
8 High School 2-1 to capture the Class 5A state softball title for the fourth consecutive year,
9 which has never been done by anyone in Class 5A; and

14 Spell, Laura Tharp, and Cody Wilson, under the tutelage of head coach Scott Nielson and
15 assistant coaches Micah Vicknair, Ashley Landry, and Gary Duhe, completed their season
16 with an outstanding winning season record of thirty-six wins, three ties, and only one loss,
17 and a district record of eleven wins and one loss; and

1 Gators softball team has earned them the 16th Ranking in the NFCA/USA Today National
