# ACT No. 345

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AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 22:636(G), relative to nonrenewal of certain insurance policies; to provide for notice of nonrenewal to persons with an interest in any loss covered by the policy; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 22:636(G) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§636. Cancellation by insurer

\* \* \*

G.(1) No insurer shall fail to renew a policy providing property or casualty insurance unless a notice of intention to not renew is mailed or delivered to the named insured at the address shown on the policy at least thirty days prior to the effective date of nonrenewal.

(2) Like notice shall also be delivered or mailed to each mortgagee, pledgee, or other known person shown by the policy to have an interest in any loss which may occur thereunder. For purposes of this Paragraph, "delivered" includes electronic transmittal, facsimile, or personal delivery.

(3) This Subsection shall not apply:

~~(1)~~ (a) To policies regulated by R.S. 22:636.1 and 636.4.

~~(2)~~ (b) If the insurer has manifested its willingness to renew the policy either through the same company or a company in the same group of companies.

~~(3)~~ (c) In the case of nonpayment of the premium.

~~(4)~~ (d) If the named insured has provided written notification to the insurer of the insured's intention to not renew the policy.
