AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 39:31(F)(2) and to enact R.S. 39:31(C)(9), relative to budgetary procedure; to require inclusion of certain information in agency operational and strategic plans; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 39:31(F)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 39:31(C)(9) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§31. Strategic planning

* * *

C. Each strategic plan shall, at a minimum, contain the following:

* * *

(9) A statement of the agency's strategies for development and implementation of human resource policies which are helpful and beneficial to women and families.

(2) In addition to the requirements of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, ~~in the development of the annual operational plan for budget development purposes in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 39:32(F);~~ each agency shall incorporate in the following elements into its operational plan, to the maximum extent practicable;:

(a) A clear delineation of the components of the annual Economic Development Action Plan developed in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 51:2381 which are applicable to the agency and shall clearly delineate those components in its operational plan.

(b) A statement of the agency's strategies for development and implementation of human resource policies which are helpful and beneficial to women and families.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2003; if vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2003, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
