Subject: Abolishment of Boards and Commissions

BOARDS/COMMISSIONS OR NO IMPACT SG EX See Note Page 1 of 2
Provides for the abolition of certain boards and commissions

Purpose of Bill: Provides for the abolition or transfer of 5 boards, commissions, political subdivisions, authorities, and like entities. The measure proposes to totally abolish the functions and responsibilities of 4 entities and transfers certain functions and responsibilities of 1 entity.

This bill also removes references in law to 6 entities that were previously abolished.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

Four (4) Entities to be Abolished

- Officials with the following three (3) entities indicated that they are inactive and there would be no fiscal impact on expenditures upon abolishment.

- 1. Advisory Council of the Louisiana Universities Marine Consortium for Research and Education
2. Louisiana Political Museum and Hall of Fame Advisory Board
3. Executive Committee of the Louisiana Systemic Initiatives Program Council

- Attempts to obtain responses for anticipated expenditure impact from the Ozarks Regional Commission have been unsuccessful. Therefore, we have been unable to determine if abolishment would have a fiscal impact on expenditures.

One (1) Entity to be Transferred This measure abolishes the inactive Louisiana Higher Education Executive Advisory Committee and transfers certain functions and responsibilities to the Board of Regents. Officials with the Board of Regents do not anticipate any impact on expenditures as a result of this transfer of duties.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
