Authorizes an increase in automobile expenses for certain judges

Purpose of Bill: This measure increases the authorized reimbursement from \$500 to \$600 per month for lease payments and expenses incurred for vehicles used by certain judges for official purposes in multiparish jurisdictions.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

This measure could increase local government expenditures by \$100,800 per year.

According to the Supreme Court's 2010 Guide to Louisiana Courts, there are 14 multiparish districts with a total of 84 judges. Assuming each judge claims the maximum amount provided in the measure of \$600, current expenditures would increase by \$100 (\$600-\$500) per month per judge, or a total of \$100,800 per year (84*100*12).

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material impact on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
