2 To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1921(B) and (C) and to enact R.S. 22:1921(D), relative to the 3 insurance fraud section of the Department of Insurance; to clarify language relative 4 to background checks; to provide for certain technical changes; and to provide for 5 related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. R.S. 22:1921(B) and (C) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 8 22:1921(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows: 9 §1921. Purpose and powers 10 11 B. In the event the applicant is a corporation, partnership, or other legal 12 entity, the criminal searches background checks shall be limited to those individuals 13 who are directors, officers, employees, or individuals who own or control at least ten 14 percent of the entity. 15 <u>C.</u> If the section has reason to believe, whether acting on its own initiative 16 or as a result of complaints, that a person has engaged in, or is engaging in, an act or 17 practice that violates this Part or any other provision of the Insurance Code, it may 18 examine and investigate into the affairs of such person and may administer oaths and 19 affirmations, serve subpoenas ordering the attendance of witnesses, and collect 20 evidence.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

C. D. If during the course of investigation, the Department of Insurance determines that there may be a violation of any criminal law, the investigation shall then be turned over to the Louisiana Department of Justice, the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, public safety services, office of state police, and other appropriate law enforcement and/or or prosecutorial agency, for further investigation, enforcement, or prosecution.

**Abstract:** Clarifies language related to criminal background checks. Makes technical changes.

<u>Present law</u> provides that criminal searches may be performed on individuals who are directors, officers, or employees of corporations, partnerships, or other legal entities that apply for a license or certificate of authority to transact a business of insurance.

<u>Proposed law</u> clarifies the term "criminal search" used in <u>present law</u> by changing it to "criminal background checks". Makes technical changes; otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

(Amends R.S. 22:1921(B) and (C); Adds R.S. 22:1921(D))
