
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Insurance to Original House Bill No. 693
by Representative Cromer

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, between lines 17 and 18, insert the following:

3 "(4) A health insurance issuer that limits the total amount paid by a
4 covered person through all cost-sharing requirements to no more than one
5 hundred dollars per filled prescription for any orally administered anti-cancer
6 medication shall be considered in compliance with this Section. For
7 purposes of this Paragraph, "cost-sharing requirements" shall include
8 copayments, coinsurance, deductibles, and any other amounts paid by the
9 covered person for that prescription."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 2

11 On page 2, between lines 18 and 19, insert the following:

12 "(1) "Anti-cancer medications" means medications used to kill or
13 slow the growth of cancer cells."

14 AMENDMENT NO. 3

15 On page 2, at the beginning of line 19, change "(1)" to "(2)"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 4

17 On page 2, at the beginning of line 22, change "(2)" to "(3)"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 5

19 On page 2, at the beginning of line 28, change "(3)" to "(4)"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 6

21 On page 3, at the beginning of line 6, change "(4)" to "(5)"

22 AMENDMENT NO. 7

23 On page 3, at the end of line 11, after "following" delete "with the" and delete line 12 in its
24 entirety and insert in lieu thereof a colon "':" "

25 AMENDMENT NO. 8

26 On page 3, between lines 15 and 16, insert the following:

27 "(3) High deductible health plans or policies that are qualified to be
28 used in conjunction with a health savings account, a medical savings account,
29 or other similar program authorized by 26 U.S.C. 220 et seq.
30 (4) Qualified health plans offered through a health benefit exchange."
