Pierre (HB 359) Act No. 192

<u>Prior law</u>, relative to insurance fraud, provided that criminal searches may be performed on individuals who are directors, officers, or employees of corporations, partnerships, or other legal entities that apply for a license or certificate of authority to transact a business of insurance.

<u>New law</u> clarifies the term "criminal search" used in <u>prior law</u> by changing it to "criminal background checks". Makes technical changes; otherwise retains <u>prior law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2012.
