

Existing law provides for the La. State Law Institute as an official advisory law revision commission, law reform agency, and legal research agency of the state of La. Provides that the governing body of the La. State Law Institute is a council composed of elected members and members who hold certain offices and who are appointed by certain persons.

New law adds two judges or their designees to the council. Provides that the additional judges shall be members of the La. Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges appointed by the president of the Louisiana Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges. Provides that one of the judges shall be a judge of a court having exclusive family or family and juvenile jurisdiction, and that the other shall be a judge of a court having exclusive juvenile or family and juvenile jurisdiction.

Effective August 1, 2012.
